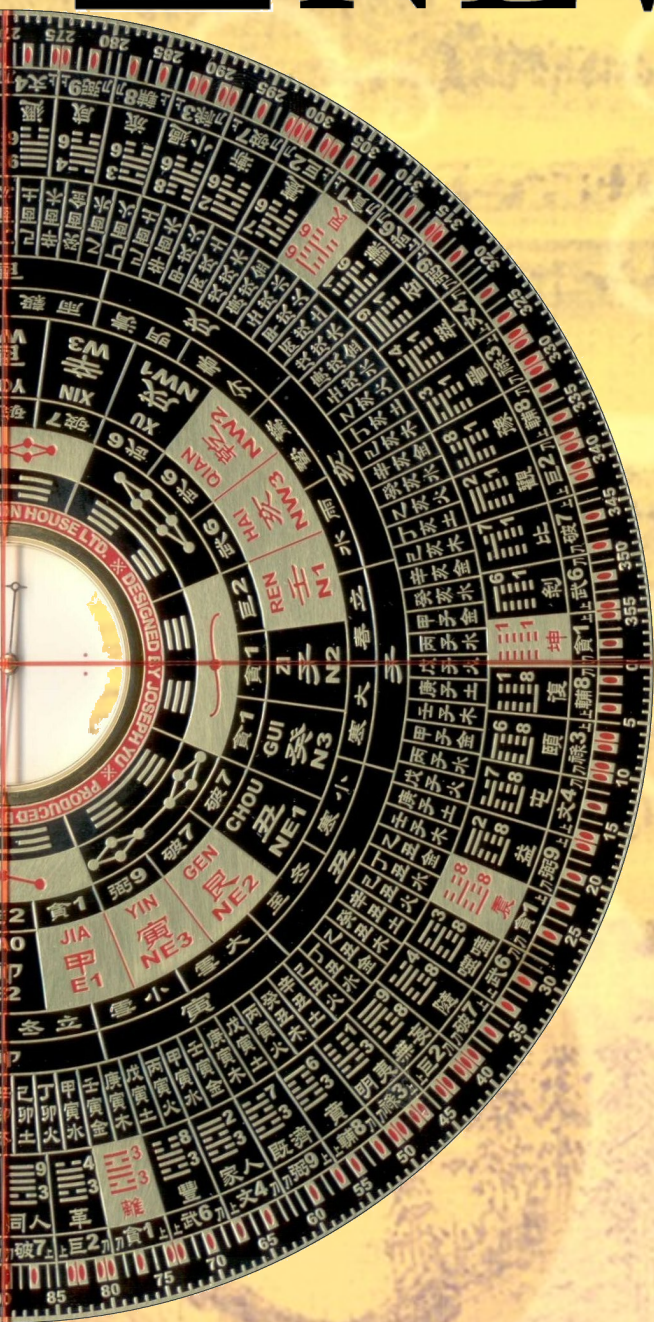

Images from magazines, advertisements, movie and social network force us to change ourselves to the seemingly more glitter images presented in such media. We often end up in disappointment and failure because reality is different and the perfect image is superficial.

This might be one of the reasons that more and more people are looking for ways to improve their lives and find their true selves. One is therefore able to pass the distance, read dozens of books, attend seminars for hours and hours listen to motivational podcasts and videos.

One of the ways to find the inner peace is Feng shui, a philosophy

teaching us to live in

harmony with the environment and nature. With feng shui we learn to listen to our intuition and follow our hearts instead of blind trust in our brain and following copied logical reasons.

Changes in the interior as a result of the precise analysis of a feng shui consultant lead to certain situations which help us to follow our destiny, instead of swimming against the river's stream.

visions and enjoy improvements afterwards.

Feng shui increases the potential to do great in your activities. For example, it will increase the chances of finding the right partner, passing an exam at your school or getting a promotion.

Your work however does not finish with interior adjustments.

Southwest modification will not help you to find a partner when you will sit at home; or a well-tuned northeast will not do the exams for you, but will help increase your chances of an excellent result if you prepare for it.

Topics left unresolved representing obstacles on your way may also open up during the process. Spoiled water has to be cleaned before crystal clear water is poured in. Hidden issues need to be resolved.

Here is an example from my practice. I was approached by a husband and wife to help improve their poor sleep and help with the problem of infertility. After just few adjustments in their home (double bed was moved to their favorable directions), the husband's affair came to the surface and within the year they

were divorced.

You might object and say well, what a "great" analysis. But, just two years after adjustments, both of them live in a new relationship, even with babies on the way. It did not all happen right away. It took some time for them to realize that their relationship was not working and they might find happiness next to someone else.

Another nice example is about a woman longing for Mr. Right. Soon after she cleaned the northwest of her apartment (until then filled with old, unnecessary stuff and clutter), men from her past, like her father, ex-lover, ex-husband began to return to her life, bringing the topics needed to be discussed.

As she decluttered her northwest, the area representing men, her relationship with men decluttered as well. This has made it clear what she expects from a relationship with a man and what kind of man she wants. She was not afraid of confrontation and work on her relationships and as a reward she now enjoys a satisfied, harmonious marriage with Mr. Right.

Feng shui clients often appreciate living a better life without unnecessary complications. I teach them to work with the five

elements – wood, fire, earth, metal and water in their homes and explain how their space "breathes" and how they can achieve great results with their own effort.

I first visit their house or apartment, then I prepare an analysis and explain everything in detail. Clients leave my practice with detailed analysis (in the form of PDF) and ready to start making adjustments.

Some changes bring immediate results, such as when using the technique of annual flying star for example; some changes take weeks or months, such as in the case of applying other Feng shui techniques.

When you have a floorplan of your living or working space and you have a compass, you can start harmonizing your home yourself according valuable books or articles on feng shui.

If the problem is less serious and less entangled, then small, simple changes will suffice and a solution will show; your situation will change.

However, if your problem is more complicated and can not be handled by yourself, it is a good idea to find a feng shui consultant who will apply sophisticated techniques to suggest remedies and help with the problem.

It is like with having a cold. When you have a runny nose, you make yourself herbal tea and you feel better. But if you have a runny nose for half a year, you have drunk liters of herbal tea and your nose is still runny, you will visit an expert who will advise you to how to get rid of your chronic problem with a special herbal remedy, he will suggest diet modification or change in your regime.

Small things affect the big ones. Even small changes can affect a huge shift in your life. It just requires willingness to have the guts to be happy.

The Feng Shui of Federal Hill-My Old Kentucky Home

Who hasn't heard of My Old Kentucky Home? The song that made Kentucky famous is played every year at Churchill Downs before the running of the most famous horse race in the world, The Kentucky Derby. It was written by Stephen Foster, a songwriter so prolific and talented his songs are still sung nearly 200 years after his birth. "My Old Kentucky Home, Goodnight" is the original title to the song that became the official song for the state of Kentucky. Federal Hill, a mansion owned by the Rowan family in Bardstown was the inspiration.

This year we face a strange pandemic. What we know about it seems to change by the hour. First it's one thing, then another. What we do know is that it's easily spread, can either kill or go unnoticed, and it seems to be everywhere. So, what does Feng Shui say about it? Studying history can help us understand what we can do to make our lives a bit easier during the pandemic.

Flying Stars

All charts are drawn with the front of the building at the bottom of the page. The numbered stars in each chart represent different types of qi. Written in the form of a triangle, each number has its own special attributes. The way they interact with each other, the environment and the people, combine to give us the Feng Shui of the building.

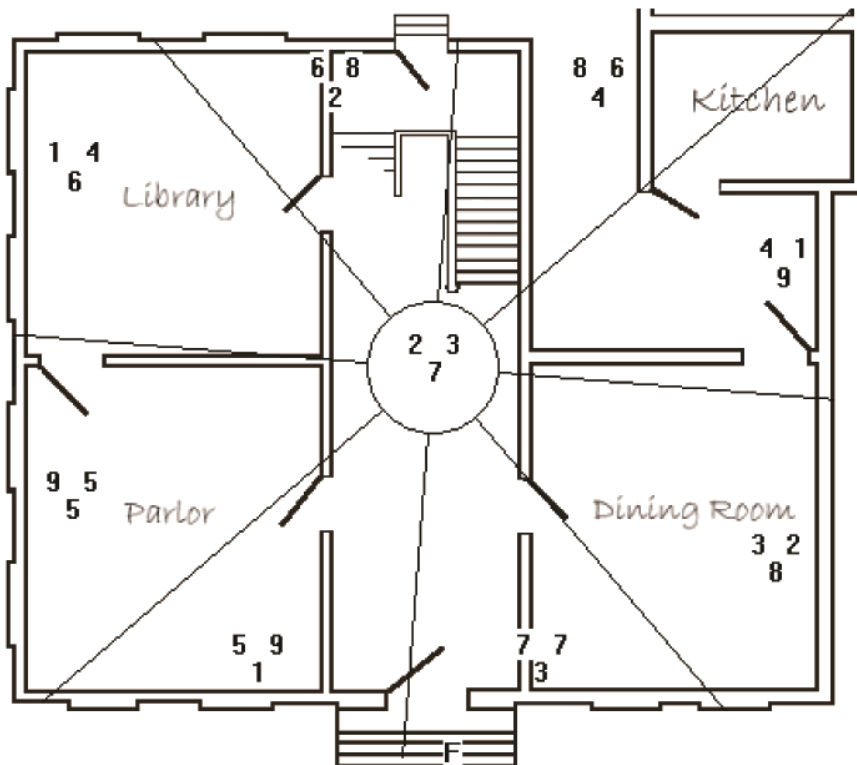
Mountain stars come first at the top left and are in charge of the inhabitants. They require stillness and solid forms. Directly to the right is the water star, in charge of the money and more active pursuits. Water stars are carried on the wind, carried by people and animals, and are encouraged by real water.

At the bottom of the triangle is the time star, providing the environment for the other two. Combinations are



written; Mountain-Time-Water. For example: 5 mountain-1 time-9 water, or 5-1-9. In individual charts yearly and monthly stars may be shown at the bottom of the triangles.

Flying Star Feng Shui Chart 1818 (7th Period)

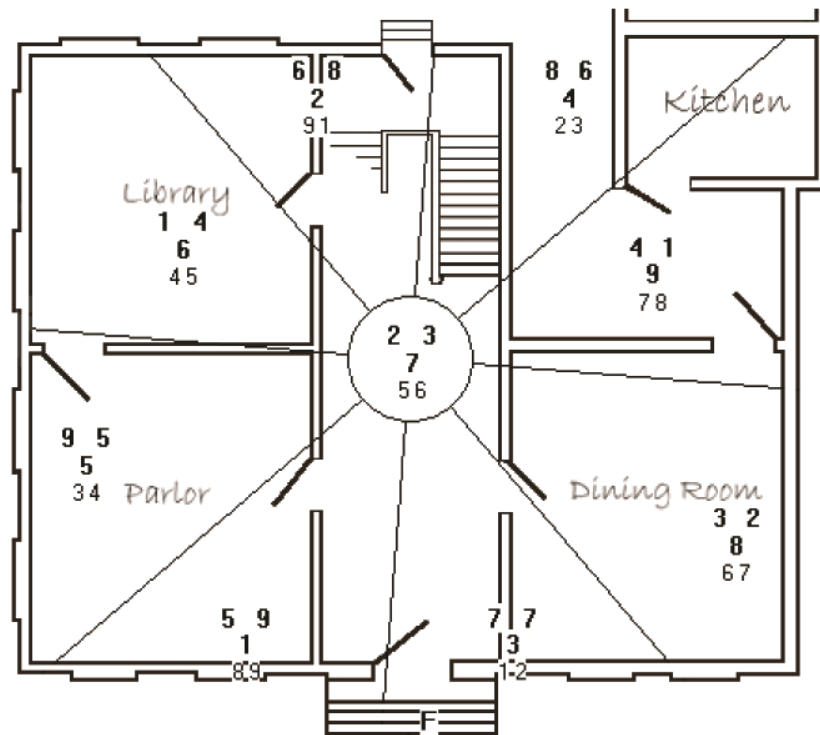


Federal Hill was built in 1818, the 7th period, and carried that chart throughout the Rowan years. The only things that changed were the annual, monthly and daily stars. The basic chart was the same.

In the 7th period the 7 water star brings prosperity. When we look at the Feng Shui of this magnificent home we notice that the 7 water star is coming in the front door. This brings money in its current period, so during these years 1818 to 1824 the house would have provided energy for a good income. It's interesting to note that the center combination of 2-3 indicates disputes...and disputes put meat on the table for a lawyer. In the rear of the house we the 6-8 and 8-6 combinations, when supported well these combinations represent wealth and fame. Judge Rowan became a very famous litigator while living in this house. For a time, both wealth and fame were evident at Federal Hill.

8th Period (1824-1844)

In 1824 the energy changed and 8th period stars began their 20 year rule. At that time the back door was bringing in the 8 water star, so it was still possible to have a good income in period 8. Judge Rowan had moved his family to Louisville in 1823, using the mansion in Bardstown for entertaining, and getting away from the city. Apparently, he was at Federal Hill often, so the Feng Shui of the house would have had some effect on him. However, his home in Louisville would have its own chart, and more influence on his life in his later years.



1833 Cholera Epidemic

The Feng Shui of the house most certainly contributed to the severity of the 1833 Cholera epidemic at Federal Hill. The bottom numbers in each triangular sequence represent the yearly and monthly stars. The dining room and parlor are used frequently, and when people walk between the two rooms they carry the water stars with them. Joining a 2 and a 5 creates a most evil combination. The 2 water star meeting the 7 mountain star suggests mouth illnesses.

Most telling though is the kitchen area. The annual 2 is visiting. The monthly 2 is also at the front door and toward the end of the month the influence would have been strongly felt. The 2 is called the monarch of sickness, and its position at the kitchen suggests food borne illness. Cholera matched perfectly.

During the epidemic a neighbor across the street noticed that his side of the street hadn't been hit by Cholera, so he offered to house some of the Rowan family to protect them from the disease. He was right. The houses on the south side of the road fared much worse than those on the north side. The charts were different, and since all the kitchens were in the rear of the houses, the yearly sickness stars were not in their kitchens. So, when the illness came to the kitchens on the south side it spread faster, was much more virulent and killed quicker.

9th Period (1844-1864)

The circular driveway out front was used in a counter-clockwise direction, taking away the current period's vibrant 9 energy, and bringing instead the 2 to the 7

In the summertime the 9 water star was more able to enter the house through the windows, but in the winter prosperity seemed a distant dream. Toward the end of this 20 year period the financial problems became worse, causing many sleepless nights.



Tragedy Strikes

The chart that inspired a songwriter also contributed three years later to the death of Judge Rowan's son, John Rowan Jr., and the long term misery of his widow. When we find the 9-5, we find fuzzy thinking and people making bad decisions. August 14, 1855 John Rowan Jr. sat on a windowsill to rest a minute after tending to a sick child. While in this precarious position, he dozed off. When his wife called him he became confused and fell out of the second story window. He died shortly afterwards. He had been strongly influenced by the 9-5 and 5-9 combinations in his

The 3-5 combination can bring serious money problems. In 1861 the annual 5 was with the 3 mountain star as well, bringing even more trouble to the already strapped household.

1st Period (1864-1884)

In 1864 the 1st period began its rule. This is when the money trouble would affect Rebecca Rowan. Her husband was gone, the Civil War was causing hardship for all, and the prosperity star for the period was blocked by the way her kitchen had been built onto the back of the house. With no access, it was useless and the household would suffer for the next 20 years.

2nd Period (1884-1904)

Things would improve in 1884 when the period 2 stars ruled. By then Rebecca Rowan's driveway brought prosperity energy with the visitors it carried to her door. The 2 water star ruled and since it was readily available, her financial situation improved considerably. Judge Rowan's estate was still not settled, but it provided well for her and the family members who lived with her at Federal Hill. Rebecca Rowan died in 1897, a beautiful and most remarkable woman.

Aside from all the other adjustments needed in the home, in this current time of global pandemic, we can see that knowing where those 2's are located can be vital. Use of a chiming clock and calabashes can ease any issues the 2 energy may bring. But, knowing where they are and how to avoid them is our best bet.

Mountain & Water Stars

Do They Exist in the Real World?...

Do Mountain Stars really exist or are they just Metaphysical concepts?

When we are looking to buy or rent a place a new building, we have a wish list that includes whether we can afford it, and if it is in the right area, and does it have the right number of rooms, and are the rooms the right size, and do they have the right fittings etc.

But although these are important considerations, the final choice in most cases seems to be based on a simple question; do you like the building, do you want to live or work there?

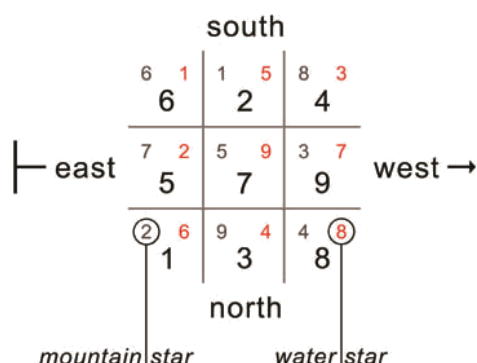
This is an entirely emotional response and many of my clients have described how, even though it didn't fulfill their wish list, they had just "felt" this was the right building for them, and in many cases they had felt this even before they got to the front door. When I worked out the Star Chart, I often found there was a Mountain

After 10 years of Feng Shui audits, I wanted to see if the number of these matches was significant from a Western Scientific point of view. I give written reports to my clients so I went through every report and created a spreadsheet. I had both the Star Chart and the Ming Guas of clients (usually husband and wife) in 411 buildings.

Because there are nine Ming Guas and nine Water, Mountain and Time Stars, you are always going to get a certain number of matches between Ming Guas and a particu-

number of matches between Ming Guas and all the Stars in the center and facing sectors, the difference is much too small to be of any significance.

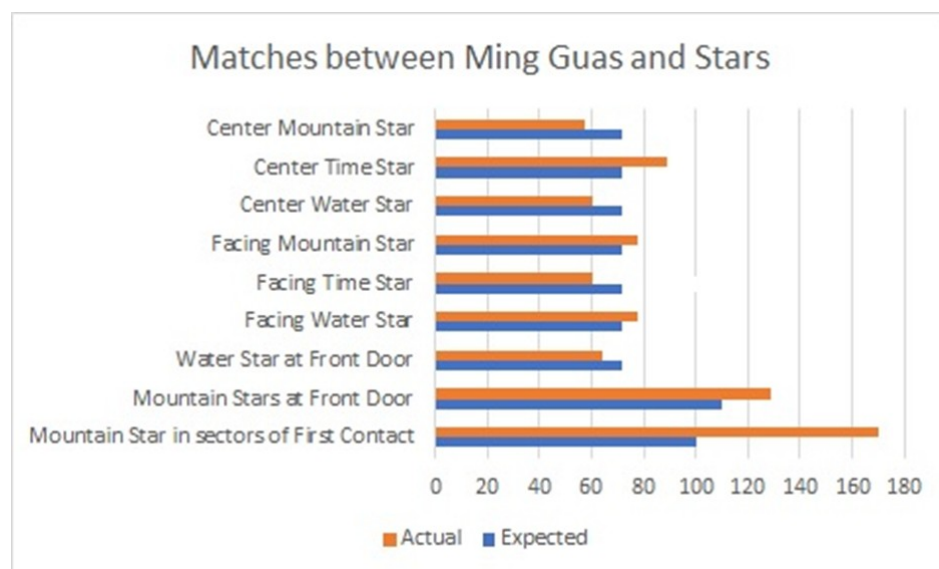
We expected more Mountain Star matches at the front door because front doors sometimes have one Mountain Star on one side and another on the other side of the door. However, the actual number of matches wasn't much more than what we expected, so again, this isn't significant from a statistical point of view.



Star at the front door that matched the number of one of their Ming Guas, and it was usually the Ming Gua of the person who had that feeling

lar Star. It is easy to work out the number of matches you could expect using simple statistics, and for the number of matches to be significant, there need to be far more actual matches than expected matches.

As you can see, there is very little difference between what was expected and the actual

However, there were 70% more matches than expected in the sector of first contact, and 70% is very significant. This is the sector you come to when you first approach the building, and it indicates that my clients were choosing their buildings based on a strong emotional response they felt when the Mountain Star in this sector matched their Ming Gua.

The question then was whether they had to physically come to the building to feel the Mountain Star, or was there some supernatural connection that influenced my clients to choose that building.

To answer this, I separated the buildings into three groups.

- First, I created a group for the buildings that were being used as business premises, because I wanted to know if people choose business premises for the same reason they choose a place to live in.
- Second, if they needed to physically come to the building to feel the Mountain Star, they wouldn't have been able to do this before the building was built, so I created a new group for the houses that had been built by my clients. I also included the houses where my clients had done major renovations and had changed the Period, because the all the Mountain Stars would now be in different sectors compared to when they first came to the building. I grouped all of these in the "Built and Renovated

houses and apartments" column.

- This left the third group of 239 houses and apartments that had been bought to be lived in without making any major renovations.

There is very little difference between expected and actual matches in business premises, so this tells us that most business premises are not chosen because of any emotional attraction. This indicates my clients were in a different frame of mind when they were looking for business premises compared to when they were looking for a "home".

The "Built and Renovated houses and apartment" column has fewer matches than expected so this shows you have to physically go to the house or apartment and feel the Mountain Star before it can have any emotional effect on you. This means there is nothing supernatural about Mountain Stars.

"If you can feel something and it can affect you, it must exist in the real world, so the "energies" we call Mountain Stars must exist, they aren't just some sort of spiritual concept."

The "Houses and Apartment bought to be lived in" column has more than double the number of matches than expected. This shows very clearly that if you are looking for a new place to live in and you physically go to a building, you actually feel the Mountain Star in the first wall you come to, and if it matches your Ming Gua, it creates a strong emotional response that greatly increases the probability you will choose to live in that house or apartment.

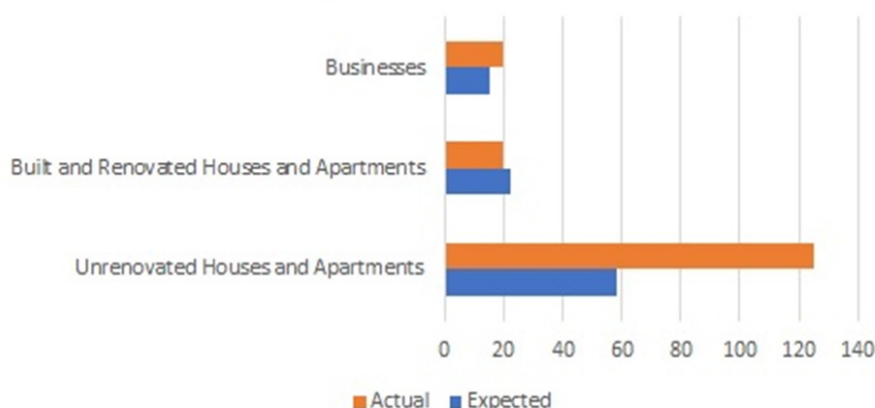
The question then was whether more than double the number of expected matches was significant from a Western Scientific Statistical point of view, or was this just a random result that could be expected? To answer this, I gave the spreadsheet to a statistician. His report basically said it is impossible to get this number of matches in this number of houses on a random basis. The only way you could get that number of matches would require some sort of "connection" between my clients and the Mountain Stars.

You cannot connect to something that doesn't exist, so Mountain Stars must exist from a Western Scientific point of view. They are not something metaphysical or supernatural, they are right there in the walls of buildings.

It also shows Mountain Stars can only affect us when we are physically close to them, and as we cannot see, hear, smell, taste or touch them, we must have some other type of sense to be able to "feel" them.....a "sixth" sense.

As Mountain Stars really do exist, it makes sense that Water Stars must also exist, and accepting Flying Stars are real and that we feel them with our "sixth sense", must change the way we think about Feng Shui.

Spring Equinox

- 2 strips of dried tangerine peel.

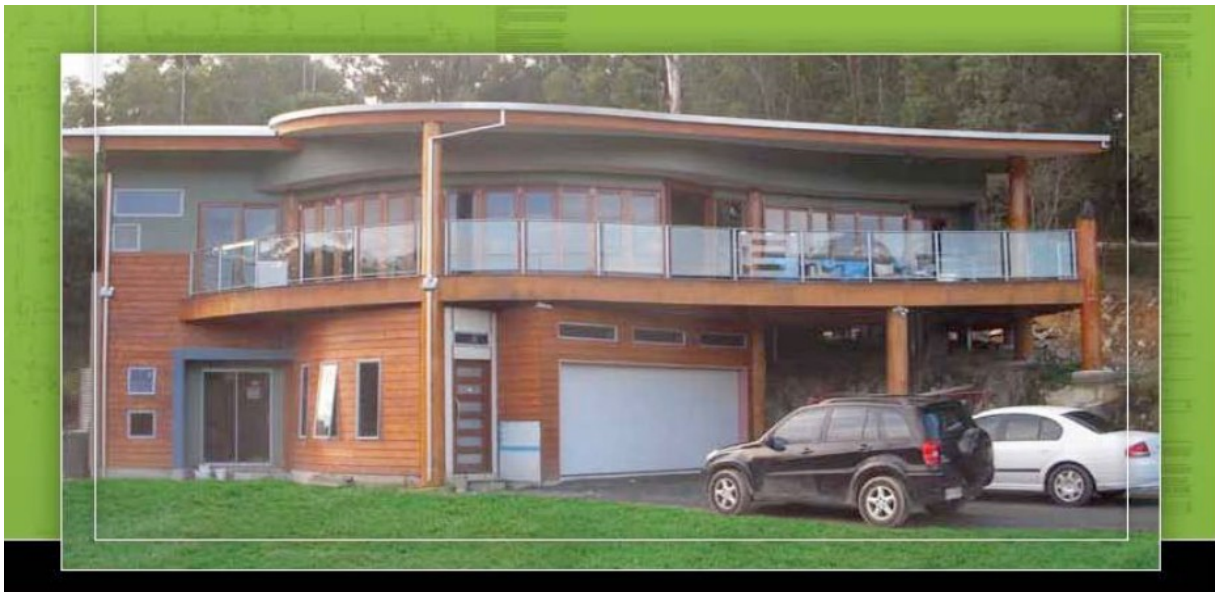

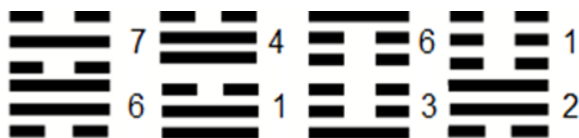

The first step was to convert the people's birth details into a series of hexagrams.



The hour, day, month and year for Mrs. A.



The day, month and year for Mr. A

Then the second step is to determine which hexagram to use for the house / door facing from the 4 pillars



In this case, the husband and wife's day hexagram is from the same family, (mountain / lake). A hexagram can be chosen from this family as the facing direction for the house.

Because the house / door will face a **blood linked hexagram** to their day hexagram there will be an intimate connection between them and the house.

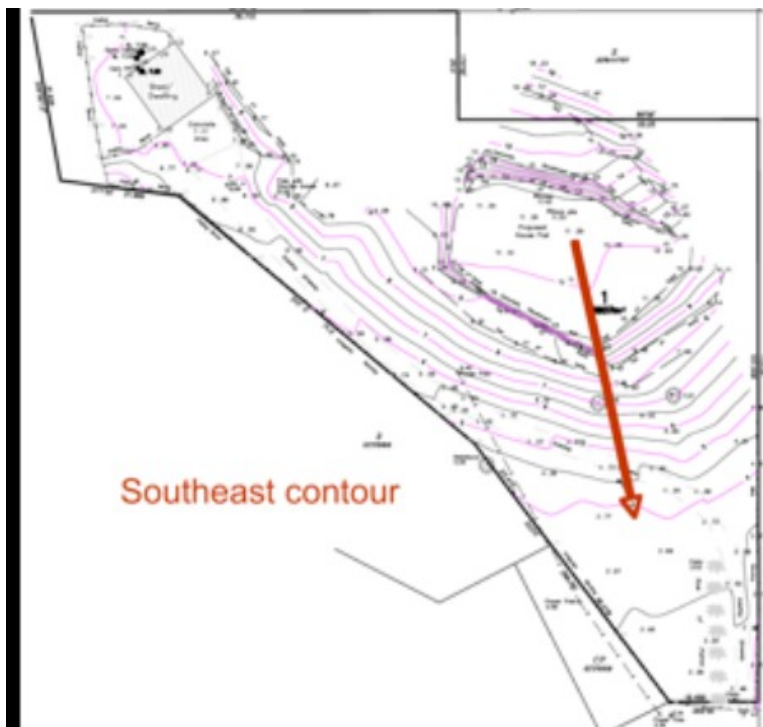
With a pad already cut on the property facing south.
The chart for South facing was overlaid on the site.

The South chart had some undesirable features:

- The entrance to the property would carry star 4 to the home, whilst the Architect could use the creativity of star 4, the risk of third-party interference in relationship was unacceptable
- The wife's Ming Gua 3 was imprisoned in the center
- The couple wanted the driveway to come to the side of the home in the east
- Water Star 5 would be admitted from the east
- Mountain Star 5 would go up the mountain in the northwest

Following the contour map, a south east orientation was possible, with some skilled engineering and creative architecture the south facing pad could be used in the house placement.

SE3 Facing

- The south east 3 orientation allows the 8 water star to be carried from the entrance to the home
- The 8 mountain star goes up the mountain
- Wife's Ming gua 3 is generated, Husbands Ming gua 8 in generating sequence
- The facing mountain is snake, Husband Birth year is snake

Melodic Element

The third step was to convert the birth year into its Melodic Element.

The melodic elements are assigned one hundred and twenty 3° divisions of the compass, called the fen jin.

Mr A birth year is 1965, his melodic element is "fire of the lamp".
Mrs A birth year is 1979, her melodic element is "fire in Heaven"

The melodic elements can generate, control, clash, drain, or enhance the birth year. In this case there are 2 fen jin in the facing hexagram chosen. fen jin (112.5 -115.5) is wood.



The fourth step is to choose which exact degree to face the house or door. The exact degree or line chosen for the house to face is determined by the technique "choosing the line to change the image".



115° Sheng Line.

Good for birth of children, establishment of new business and starting new projects

118° Wealth Line.

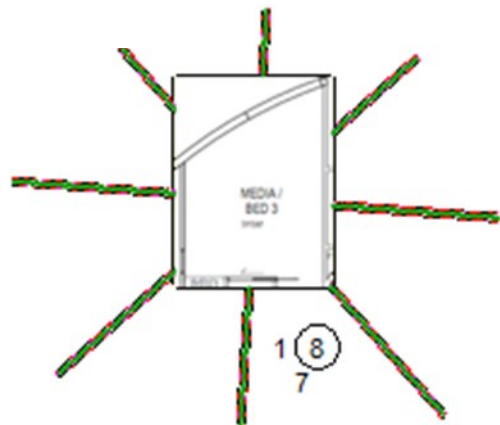
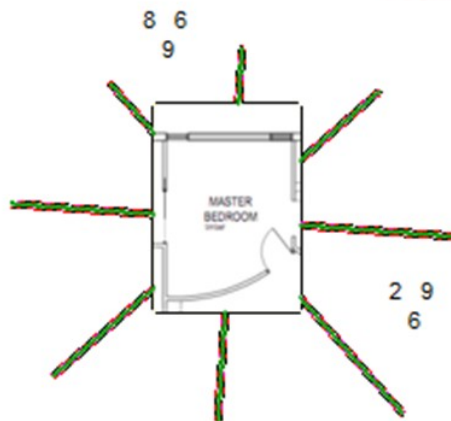
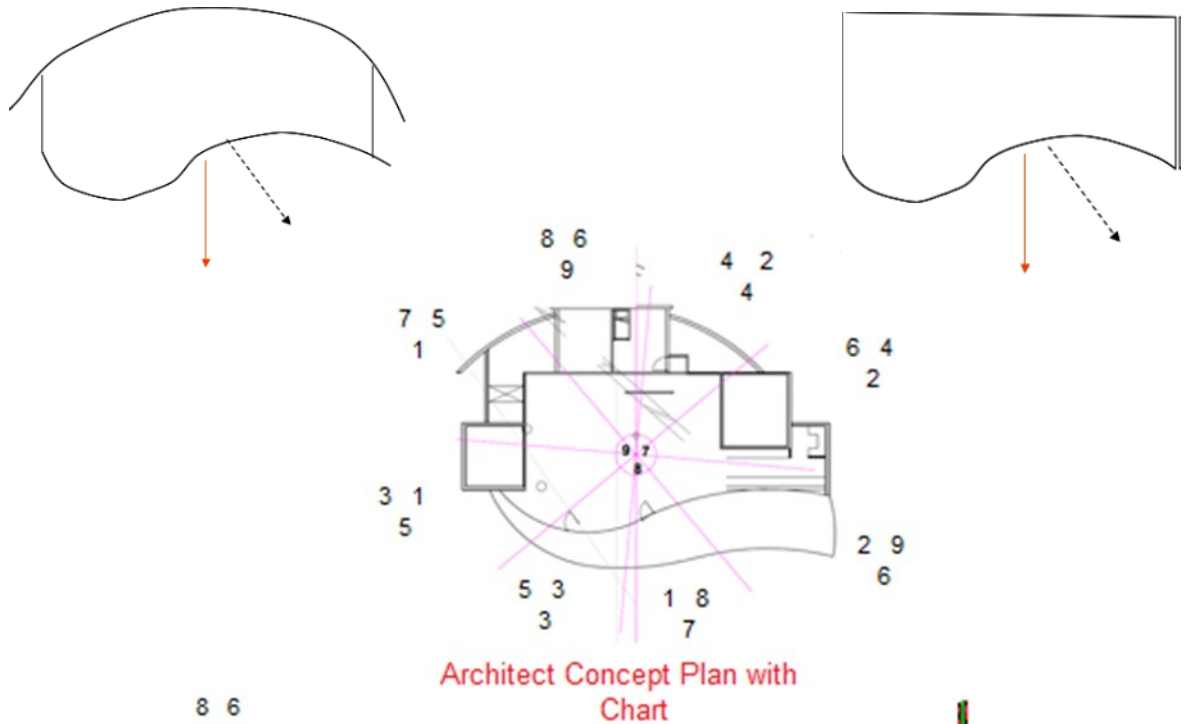

The house or door can face any of these precise degrees according to the client's preference.

Due to the site contour the house must face SE3, therefore the hexagram and feng jin and precise degree was used for the main entrance as well as all the other doors. To overcome the difference between the house and door orientation a design concept was developed.



All rooms and wall form He Tu or generating combinations

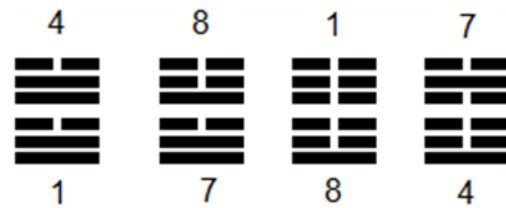

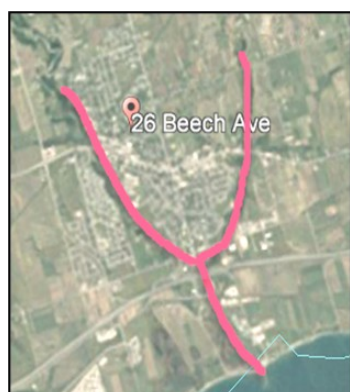

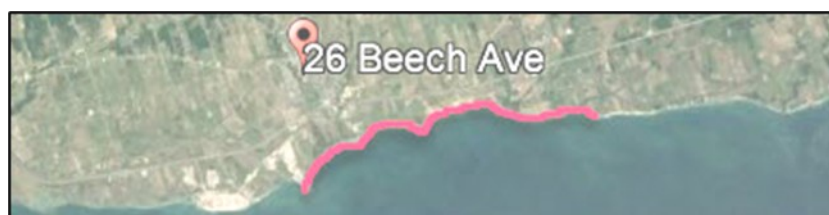

- * All of which Dr. Low was known. But the personality of a Gua 3 is not suited to politics. He was not successful when running for office.

Gua 3 has a special skill that gives them great speed abilities. Majority Gold Metal Winners in sports are often Gua 3.

Dr. Low may have spent a lot of time in the South. It is strong in medical Qi. SE and SW is strong in cutting skill Qi.

- * He was well known and sought after for his speed as a surgeon. This was a sought-after skill as Anaesthetic use was not yet available!

- * Dr. Low is now using his natural abilities with the Qi type prominent in his space; his home; Speed, Medical,

The SW and East have combos that promote fellowship and networking. That combines with the energy in the NE and would give the space a party energy. It generated a “feel good” space and was a natural draw for people gatherings.

Period9 generates this party energy even more and the Low’s are known for their lavish parties.

- * Good thing the current energy is good for making money.
- * His favorite place to sit was probably the west. It would assist him in being a winner in his field, and that he was.

Dr. McLaughlin, Gua 7 – Purchased 1874

Since Dr McLaughlin’s Gua type was found at the front of the house, it may have been a case of “Love at first sight” when he first saw this house. I suspect his favourite spot in the house may have been in the SW.

- * Exposure to a window in the south and a wall in the SW would be an optimum place for a skilled surgeon to soak in a type of energy that promotes these abilities.

In addition to the medical energies natal to this house, it still had all the energies promoting parties and gaiety. Except now it doesn’t have the energy to promote the money it did before the Period changed

- * 1867 the house enters into a new time cycle, Period1.

What was good for money before is now good for money troubles.

- * The lavish party energy is still strong however, yet the money is not and may have contributed to the selling and downsizing of the lot .

- * The Political energy in Period1 is strong and is reflected in Dr. McLaughlin’s natural speaking ability and natural people pleasing manner of Gua 7. A political natural, he wins a seat in the Legislative Assembly in 1879 and again in 1883...however, in 1886 he barely wins

by only 3 votes.

- * In 1886 it has now entered into another cycle, Period 2, and the strong political influence has changed and is not as active as it had been during the previous period. It is now more augmentative and this may have put his voters off.

- * The property is handed down to his children and remains in the family until 1937. It then becomes a training school for German Prisoner of War boys.

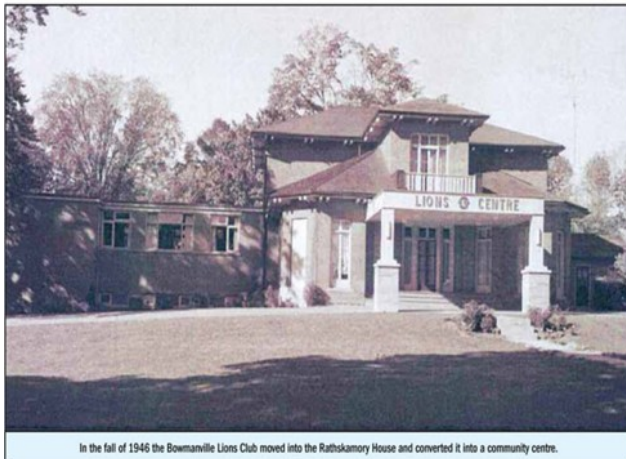

- * 1953 a major renovation extends the building on the south and west sides. This changes the Qi type from parties, medicine, and politics to **money loss, litigation and control**.

- * **1964 brings in a new Period6.**

The energy is now a little more balanced and should be generating some wealth opportunities.

- * **1984 Period 7 arrives and the return of the financial problems.**

This has not been a good investment for the Club.

The interior Qi controls the people spending time there. This likely influenced poor management and suppliers taking advantage. Maybe the Lions Club thinks it is time to move on, and agrees to sell.

- * **1998 the property is sold to the Municipality of Clarington .**

It intends to operate as a non-profit activity center for seniors.

- * **1998 Renovations continue with an extension on the north side.**

In the fall the center reopens with a new Qi flow chart, Period7.

This has a reverse chart pattern meaning that the flow is backward. The organization may have not been making enough money during this period.

Then in 2004 a new Period8 level is added. This along with the addition on the north side with its new entrance would make the business more profitable than it had been for some time. The current Noble energy is now at the main entrance. This means new opportunities will present themselves. It also picked up a special energy called Yan Nian or helpful people (maybe this is good teachers will come here).

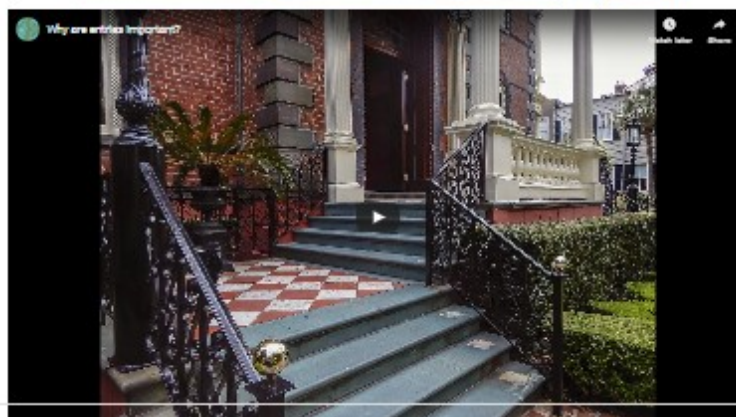
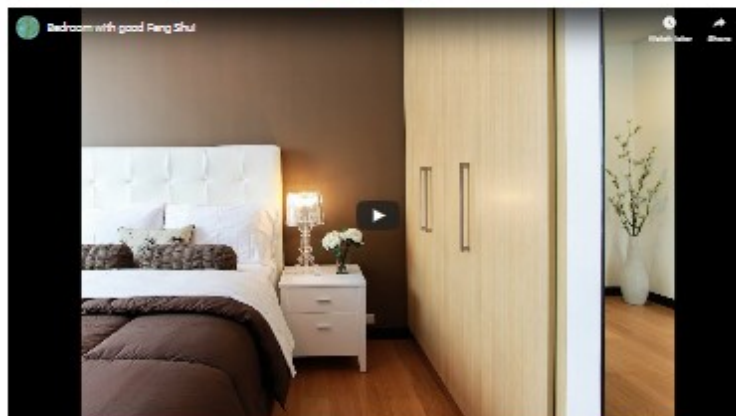

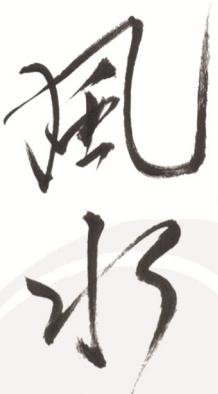
